1. **TUITION**

You have the option of paying for the entire year or in five payments. There is a \$30 discount per year for the second child in a family and a \$40 discount for the third child. The 2009-2010 season consists of **thirty-four weeks**; August-June. JOB accepts payments in the forms of cash, check and money order. **Payments are due by the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the billing month(s).** Receive a 10% discount if you pay in full for the fall classes by June 5. Payment for classes is due by the 20<sup>th</sup> of August, October, January, March, and April if you use the five payment plan. All payments should be mailed or put in the tuition slot at the desk. Payments received after the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month will incur a \$20.00 late fee for each month that tuition is delinquent. **Note: no refunds are given at JOB; therefore consider that before deciding on your payment plan.** Accounts not paid within 15 days of the date will receive a Final Notice. If payment is not received within 15 days of the Final Notice, the student's enrollment may be suspended. If at any time you experience financial difficulties which prevent you from making payment in a timely manner, please notify Dawn Meyer or Judy Schwing immediately so that a payment plan can be arranged. **There will be a service fee of \$30 for a returned check.** If your check is returned more than two times, you must pay with cash for the remainder of the year. **After May 15 all payments for tuition, costumes, or recital fees must be made in the form of cash or money order.** Note: Performance Team classes are charged an additional 10% due to the higher level of expertise needed to teach these classes. Students taking 7 or more hours (excluding acro) will not be charged for more than 7 hours.

2. **BOYS PROGRAM**

Boys at JOB can take a tuition free semester of dance in tap, jazz, or hip hop. (This excludes Registration fee, costumes, and Recital fees) Please see Dawn, Kathy, or Judy for more information.

3. **ATTENDANCE**

Attendance in class is crucial for a dancer's development. When emergencies arise, dancers are expected to notify the studio prior to the class. See teacher for a list of appropriate make-up classes. **No refunds will be given for classes missed due to illness and or cancellation due to weather.** Students may come and make-up in a comparable class during the regular dance year or summer session. If a student incurs a long term injury, it is the parents' responsibility to submit an injury credit request. Classes should be observed by the dancer if recital dances are being choreographed.

4. **CLEANLINESS**

For the health and comfort of all our students, please pay close attention to personal hygiene. Students are expected to clean up after themselves in the classes and the break room.

5. **ATTIRE**

Dancers should be dressed appropriately for class using following guidelines:

- Ballet - Levels Pre-VI: pink canvas/leather ballet shoes, solid color leotard, pink/tan/black tights  
Levels VI-X/PT classes Mon./Wed. pink ballet shoes, black leotard, pink tights  
All Levels: hair **must** be in bun
- Tap - Levels Pre-II: tan tap shoes, solid color leotard, pink/suntan/black tights  
Levels III-IX/PT: tan jazz oxford tap shoes, solid color leotard, pink/suntan/black tights  
Level PT: black jazz oxford tap shoes (CG55) or suntan character pumps (if recital dance requires), solid color leotard, pink/suntan/black tights or shorts and tank tops
- Jazz - Levels I-II: pink ballet shoes, any color of leotard, pink/suntan/black tights  
Levels III-V: slip on tan jazz shoes, any color of leotard, pink/suntan/black tights  
Levels VI-X/PT: slip on tan jazz shoes, any color of leotard, pink/suntan/black tights/shorts and tank tops if approved by teacher
- Tumbling – All Levels: no shoes, any color leotard, biker shorts and footless tights.  
Stretch – See teacher for shoes, any color of leotard, footless/convertible tights or shorts and tank top.  
Hip Hop – All Levels: Close fitting tank top and black dance pants or capris with clean gym shoes. Hair must be pulled back.
- Hip Hop I & II- No shoes required  
Creative Movement – Pink ballet shoes, any color leotard and convertible/transitional tights. Hair must be pulled back.  
Musical Theatre – Shorts, t-shirt, comfortable shoes (no flip flops)  
Boys - May wear a T-shirt and sweat pants or shorts to class and the appropriate shoes.

6. **COMMUNICATION**

Monthly newsletters and our new JOB website will be your main source of communication. Newsletters may be picked up at the desk or are available on our website, justoffbroadway.net. Phone calls and e-mails will be returned in a timely matter. Any problems with our communication system should be directed to the business manager, Judy Schwing.

7. **FORMS**

Please make sure that registration forms are completed and up to date as this is our only method of contacting you or the designated persons if the need arises. **To ensure your account is accurate, it is the responsibility of each parent to complete add / drop forms for any class changes.**

8. **QUESTIONS OR PROBLEMS**

9. **PARENTS' OBSERVATION**

Parents are invited to observe classes one designated week in the winter. When observing Levels II and under, no younger siblings may attend as it is distracting to the students in the class. **Parents are also requested to silence cell phones and refrain from talking during the class out of respect to the dancers and teachers.**

10. **PRIVATE LESSONS**

Private lessons are available to all students at JOB. See the Solo/Duet form for prices. Payment to the teacher is due at the time of the lesson. Arrangements can be made by calling the Studio.

11. **SNOW POLICIES**

Morning classes will follow West Clermont School District's cancellations. Early afternoon students should call the studio after 11:00 and late afternoon students should call after 2:00 p.m. to check on class cancellations.

12. **COSTUMES/TIGHTS**

Costume and tights fees are due by December 1 for the Spring Recital. Prices for levels Pre-III and Hip Hop classes will be \$65.00. Levels IV-IX and PT classes will be \$85.00. Costume & tights are partially refundable before January 15 and can be canceled with a \$25 cancellation fee. Partial payments for costumes can be made beginning in September. See the desk for details.

13. **RECITAL FEE**

Each family is required to pay a recital fee of \$70.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> dancer & an additional \$20 for each additional dancer due the first week of May. This fee is mandatory for performance in the spring recital. Each family receives 5 complimentary tickets for the recital. Technique classes & some PT classes do not do a recital dance.

14. **RECITAL PROCEDURE**

JOB's dress rehearsal and recital is held at Mason High School. All students are required to attend dress rehearsal to review their dances. At dress rehearsal, video taping is permitted. During the recital, videotaping & flash photography are not permitted; video cameras will not be permitted in the auditorium. Audience members will not be permitted to leave auditorium while a dance is in progress. Parents may leave to dress their child only after a number has finished. No siblings are permitted in the dressing room area during dress rehearsal or the recital. All students must stay in the dressing room area during the show when they are not performing. Most classes will have a Helping Mom throughout the year. If you are interested in this position, please see your teacher or front desk.

**We have festival seating for the dance recital, the Theater doors open approximately 15 minutes before the show. Additional tickets will be available after May 1 for \$10 at the studio or at the theatre. We will offer Senior Citizen discounts the day of the show.**

15. **CONFERENCES**

Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held at JOB during the months of November/December. At this time, parents can discuss their child's progress/leveling/test steps and any other questions or concerns. Spring Conferences will be available upon request.

16. **STUDENT REFERRALS**

NEW: Each family will receive a \$50 credit for each new student they refer to the studio. (This does NOT pertain to siblings). \$25.00 will be applied to your account in September and the balance in May when the referred student completes his or her year at JOB.
